Day 0- Oct. 24 – Day of rest (2-nights in Accra)

Arrival in Ghana: Akwaaba– Welcome Rest from your long Flight!

Arrive in Accra, Ghana. Transfer from airport to your hotel. Check into your hotel. **Overnight at [Accra](#). Meals Included: Dinner**

Day 1

Accra City Tour

After breakfast, depart for a sightseeing tour of Accra. You will drive through the administrative and economic districts of Accra, the capital of Ghana. This 137-year-old city has a blend of colonial and modern architecture that summarize her history. You will visit the W. E. B. Dubois Centre for Pan African Culture, Independence/ Black Star Square and Kwame Nkrumah Memorial Park. End your tour at the Arts Centre where you will have an opportunity to use your bargaining skills to shop from an open-air market for artefacts from Ghana and West Africa. **Overnight at [Accra](#). Meals Included: Breakfast and Dinner.**



Day 2- (2-nights in Koforidua)

Ohene Cocoa Farm -Early rise we will head off for a tour at the **Ohene Cocoa Farm**. After the Cocoa farm, we will head to Koforidua. (Late hotel check-in)



Day 3

Effiduase, Koforidua – Visit Effiduase GapBuster Education Program:

After breakfast check out of your hotel and depart for Koforidua, the Capital Town of Eastern Region. You will meet with kids of **Effiduase GapBuster Education Program. Overnight at Koforidua.**

Day 4- (3-nights in Kumasi)

The Ashanti Empire – Kumasi City Tour

After breakfast we head off to Kumasi (early departure), check out of your hotel and drive through the forest zone to Kumasi, the seat of the Ashanti Empire to explore the legends of the famous Ashantis, whose legacies are still evident today. Continue your drive to Kumasi where you will visit The **Okomfo Anokye Sword** and **Manhyia Palace Museum** to obtain firsthand information on the legacies of the Ashanti kingdom. A regal history that dates back to 1700 is told with relics and artifacts. Enjoy a drive through the city with monuments dedicated to the memory of the great Ashanti people. End the day's tour at the National Cultural Center that features the Prempeh II Jubilee Museum and various studios of the brass makers, potters and batik makers. **Overnight at [Kumasi](#).**



Meals Included: Breakfast and Dinner.

Day 5

Ashanti Craft Villages – Kumasi

After breakfast, depart your hotel and devote this day to visiting Ntonso, the home of Adinkra cloth, and Bonwire, the Kente weaving village. You will have an opportunity to see how African crafts are made and to buy directly from the artisans who make them. **Overnight at [Kumasi](#). Meals Included: Breakfast & Dinner**

Day 6- Day of Rest with options to visit the Kumasi Central Market - Kejetia, Kumasi, Ghana.

The **Kumasi Central Market** (also known as Kejetia Market) is an open-air market in the city of Kumasi, the capital of Ashanti. Kumasi Central Market is in the rain forest bioregion of Ashanti on the Ashantiland Peninsula. After the market, we will head off the Cape Coast (late hotel check-in)



Day 7-(3-nights in Cape Coast)

Cape Coast & Elmina – Cape Coast and Elmina Slave Dungeons

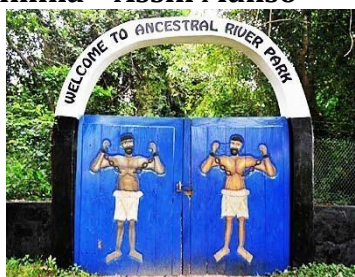
After breakfast, depart hotel and embark on a tour of the infamous Forts, Castles and Slave Dungeons of Ghana. History will unfold the story of the slave trade which the impact is still felt beyond the shores of Africa today. Visit the Cape Coast Castle built by the Swedes in 1653 and was later taken over by the British. This castle also houses the West African Historical Museum established by the Smithsonian Institute in collaboration with the Ghanaian Government in 1994.

After lunch on your own, you will visit the Elmina Castle built by the Portuguese in 1482 and also known as St. George's Castle. This castle was the first European structure built in Sub-Saharan Africa. The colorful harbor nestled below the Elmina Castle, full of pirogues preparing to go to sea offers one of West Africa's greatest photo opportunities. **Overnight at [Cape Coast](#). Meals Included: Breakfast and Dinner.**



Day 8

Elmina – Assin Manso



After breakfast, depart your hotel and make a scenic drive to **Assin Manso**. to visit the site of "Donkor Nsuo", the former Slave River and market, the final transit point for a large number of enslaved Africans. This is the final resting place for two ancestors whose mortal remains were returned from the **USA and Jamaica** and **reinterred** there.

Overnight at [Cape Coast](#). Meals Included: Breakfast and Dinner.

Day 9- (2-days in Accra)

Accra Market Tour or Ghana National Mosque – Early-rise heading to Accra



You will have the option of visiting the Ghana National Mosque or going to the Makola Market in Ghana. The Mosque is the second largest mosque in West Africa. The mosque was built at a cost of \$10 million. It was funded by the Turkish Hudai Foundation in Accra with the support of the Turkish government. The complex includes a residence for the imam, a school and a library.

Discover an **Open-Air Market** in **Accra Makola Market** with over **45,000 stalls**. Find handicrafts and souvenirs from around the country, including glass beads, batik fabrics, and woodcarvings, then watch metal traders transform scrap into innovative new pieces, and sample freshly-made delicacies in the bustling capital of Ghana. **Overnight at [Accra](#) . Meals Included: Breakfast and Dinner.**

Day 10- Nov. 3

Farewell/Departure in the evening

Last minute shopping and packing. Transfer to airport for check-in and final departure back home.
